3. Adoption of Agenda

Chair amended the agenda to include discussion of new Washington State Democratic Central Committee Code of Conduct/Ethics. Adoption of amended Agenda Moved/2nd, motion carried.

Code of Conduct/Ethics

David Rose introduced the WSDCC Code of Conduct/Ethics, applicable to all state party members. Neil Norman moved that we endorse the Code of Conduct/2nd. Motion carried unanimously.

Citizen's Complaint

David Rose reported that Freedom Foundation member Glen Morgan has filed a number of citizens complaints with the Washington State Attorney General, including a complaint against us. The AG can choose to act by filing a lawsuit or not. We consulted with the Washington State Democrats, who recommended taking advantage of their contract with lawyer Dmitri Iglitzin, as he is handling the other complaints made by Morgan. The E-Board took an email vote and contacted with Dmitri to represent us at \$275 per hour, billable in 0.1 Hr increments, no retainer. Iglitzin will bill WSDCC, we will reimburse WSDCC. Initial contact has been made, contract has been signed. John Christenson moved/2nd Carl Baker to support hiring Dmitri Iglitzin. Passed without dissent.
