Respect and Freedom for Journalism

WHEREAS journalism is the only profession explicitly protected by the U.S. Constitution;¹ and

WHEREAS a press corps that calls out government failures at all levels is fundamental to the functioning of all democracies; and

WHEREAS journalism is under attack from the highest levels of government, with President Donald Trump regularly excoriating what he considers unfavorable coverage as "fake news," and calling the news media the "enemy of the American people;" and

WHEREAS the UN's Special Rapporteurs on Freedom of Expression, and on Human Rights, issued a joint statement August 2, 2018, saying, "These attacks [by Trump] run counter to the country's obligations to respect press freedom and international human rights law," and

WHEREAS in 2018 to date, 24 journalists have been attacked, including in June of 2018 a gunman killing 4 journalists and a member of the staff of the Capital Gazette newsroom in Annapolis, Maryland;³ and

WHEREAS as pointed out by the American Civil Liberties Union,⁴ "The media, especially in national security cases, serves as an essential check against government malfeasance and can function only when it can guarantee the safety and anonymity of sources;" and

WHEREAS Attorney General Jeff Sessions, asked in a House Judiciary Committee hearing whether he would commit to not jailing journalists for protecting their sources responded, "There are some things that the press seems to think they have an absolute right to... they do not have an absolute right to;⁵" and

WHEREAS federal "media shield" laws, such as the bi-partisan Free Flow of Information Act (H.R. 4382), have passed in the House of Representatives,⁶ only to die in the Senate;⁷

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washington State Democrats recognize, and call upon legislators at all levels to uphold the values of a free and vibrant news media, including traditional, digital, and independent media; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Washington State Democrats call upon Washington States' senators to cosponsor a media shield law congruent with the Free Flow of Information Act.
